- develop a better understanding of the factors driving salmon abundance and the challenges facing them;

- support conservation and restoration strategies to help manage salmon in the face of climate change;
- enable collaboration among organizations and researchers in countries throughout the Northern Hemisphere;
- inspire and support a new generation of researchers, managers, and conservationists;
- help create a greater awareness of the ecological, social, cultural and economic value of salmon; and
- support research and conservation of salmon species and their environments throughout the Northern Hemisphere.

The IYS Co-ordinating Committee welcomes the use of the IYS resources and logo by any interested party. Outreach and research activities using the IYS logo must be related to wild salmon conservation at a hemispheric, international, national, regional or local level that are consistent with these aims and the main outreach and research themes of the International Year of the Salmon.

Three colour logo for embroidery

The three colour logo should only appear on a white cap

Artwork should be approximately 85mm x 55mm, to ensure clarity of text and graphic. This should be a fairly standard size for manufacturers. You can provide this visual as a guide.

OTHER CAPS

A white single colour version of the logo for embroidery.

This should ONLY appear on teal caps. The cap shade should be a close match to Pantone 7472 C

Artwork should be approximately 85mm x 55mm, to ensure clarity of text and graphic. This should be a fairly standard size for manufacturers. You can provide this visual as a guide.
